

ECSU set to extend Halloween for kids

WILLIMANTIC—Eastern Connecticut State University will host its yearly Halloween Party for the school district a couple days after the holiday.

The event — called “Eastern’s Not So Scary Halloween Party” — will be on Saturday Nov. 2, from noon to 3 p.m. and it is being dubbed an “after Halloween” celebration for town school children.

According to event organizers, the free party is for local schoolchildren in kindergarten through fourth-grade, especially those from Natchaug, North Windham, Sweeney, Windham Center elementary schools, the Barrows STEM Academy and the early childhood center.

Children in the town will be able to participate in crafts, games, story time and trick-or-treating during this time period. Snacks will also be provided for the children.

The party will be at the ECSU campus, 83 Windham St., in North Campus’ Niejadlik Hall and it is being sponsored by ECSU’s Office of Housing and Residential Life.
