

You must meet the following conditions in order to qualify for the CT Tuition Waiver

1. Served **90 days active duty** during a **specified war time** (see dates below).
2. Be **honorably** discharged from the U.S. Armed Forces.
3. Provide a **member 4** copy of your **DD-214** (with specified dates of pertinent time of service).
4. Be domiciled (place of residence treated as a permanent home) in Connecticut at the time of acceptance to Eastern Connecticut State University.
5. Be a matriculated student (officially accepted to ECSU through the Admissions office with an acceptance letter in a degree-seeking program.)

Eligibility ceases upon withdrawal, dismissal, and/or graduation

PERIODS OF SERVICE

Served at least **90 days** on **active duty**:

- Korean Hostilities: **June 27, 1950 – January 31, 1955**
- Vietnam: **February 28, 1961 – July 1, 1975**
- Persian Gulf Era: **August 2, 1990 – a date to be determined** by Presidential proclamation or federal law (Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm, Enduring Freedom (*Afghanistan*) and Iraqi Freedom are included in this category).

OR, ENGAGED IN COMBAT OR COMBAT SUPPORT ROLE:

- Lebanon Conflict: **July 1, 1958 – November 1, 1958**
- Peace-keeping Mission in Lebanon: **September 29, 1982 – March 30, 1984**
- Grenada Invasion: **October 25, 1983 – December 15, 1983**
- Operation Earnest Will: **July 24, 1987 – August 1, 1990**
- Panama Invasion: **December 20, 1989 – January 31, 1990**

CT Tuition Waiver for Veterans covers:

- 100% tuition for credit courses in the Fall and Spring sessions
- 50% course fee for Extension Fund courses (summer and intersession credit courses)

*The waivers do **not** cover various fees charged to the student.*

**You are responsible for all fees and other charges such as books, student activity, parking, course fees, and room and board.

CT Tuition waivers are granted only to those who served on “active duty**” not those who served on “**active duty for training.**”
