-If on active duty for more than 90 days after Sep 10 2001

Montgomery GI Bill Active Duty (MGIB-AD)

- Active Duty members who pay \$100 per month for a whole year. They are entitled to education benefits.

Montgomery GI Bill Active Duty (MGIB-AD)

-For reservists with a six year obligation.

Follow these steps to apply for your benefits:

STEP 1. Bring the following forms to the Financial Aid Office:

- a. *Certificate of Eligibility (COE)
- b. * Data Form
- c. * tuition form – If applicable
- d. Copy of your DD 214 member 4 (not appl. For dependents)
- e. Course Plan (for Bachelors of General Studies major only)

STEP 2. Paperwork Processing

The staff in the VA Financial Aid office will process this request for you. They will send the request to the VA-Educational Office in Buffalo, NY. (3-4-week process time).

Once the information is verified, you will receive a letter from the VA with approval.
