

## **Eastern Connecticut State University Freshman Preference Registration (FPR) Fall 2011**

Welcome to Eastern Connecticut State University! In order for you to begin the preregistration process for the Fall 2011 semester you must complete **Freshman Preference Registration (FPR)**, accessible through eWeb, Eastern's Online Services platform.

### **Accessing the Freshman Preference Registration (FPR)**

**Beginning May 2nd and ending at midnight June 13th**, the Freshman Preference Registration online process will be available to incoming first-year students who have paid their tuition deposits. Please be aware that the earlier you select your preferred courses, the higher the probability is that you will be able to enroll in those courses. - Click on Login
- Enter your 8-digit Eastern ID provided with your acceptance letter and your eWeb PIN
- Click the Admissions tab
- Watch the "Liberal Arts Core/First-Year Program Presentation" and the "FPR Tutorial" by clicking the appropriate links. **It is extremely important that you view these videos prior to selecting courses**
- Click the Freshman Preference Registration link to begin the pre-registration process
- Select your courses

It is in your best interest to complete the Freshman Preference Registration as soon as possible. Pre-registration must be completed prior to attending [SOAR](#) (Student Orientation Advising and Registration) and must be completed no later than June 13, 2011. Once again, early completion of the FPR process will increase your chances of receiving your preferred courses. Also, failure to participate in the SOAR Program may result in the cancellation of your Freshman Preference Registration schedule.

### **Course Load**

All first-year students must register for a **minimum of 15 credits** and cannot exceed the **maximum of 17 credits**. If you are unable to register for at least 12 credits through the FPR, please contact the Advising Center using the information below. If you are able to register for at least 12 credits using the FPR, the Advising Center staff will assist you to select additional credits during SOAR.

### **Math and Writing Placement**

Incoming students are placed into appropriate Math and Writing courses. General information about both the Math and Writing Placement is available [here](#). There will also be a guide to registering for Math and Writing courses in Sections II and III of the FPR.
