- Nominations are invited from Eastern Connecticut State University and the general community for the Annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Distinguished Service Awards. Nominations must be received by **Thursday, February 1, 2007**.
- The awards recognize members of the campus and community-at-large whose actions demonstrate distinguished service in promoting the ideals of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. to further the goals of diversity and social equity.
- Three awards will be presented to a member of the faculty or staff, a student, and a community member. The awards will recognize distinguished service in one or more of the following areas:
 1. Demonstrated activity that represents a commitment to the goals of an integrated society. These should include activities beyond one's work obligations (or educational obligations in the case of a student nominee).
 2. Demonstrated leadership in a program serving the needs of a diverse community. Efforts should reflect an attempt to unify groups and/or to increase sensitivity.
 3. Planning and implementation of programs to broaden representation of under-represented groups.

Nomination packets should include this form and a statement regarding the nomination of the individual which highlights their work to further the ideals of Dr. King and enrich the community.
