- Tier 1 Prerequisite required to be completed before taking Linked Tier 1 Category
- → One tier 1 Prerequisite required to be completed before taking Linked Tier 2 Category
- → → Tier 1 Prerequisite strongly encouraged before taking linked Tier 2 Category
- → → → Two Tier 2 Prerequisite categories to be completed before taking Tier 3 Capstone

++ All students must complete either a Tier 1 or Tier 2 Natural Science course (T1NS or T2NS) with a lab so that a total number of credits between T1NS and T2NS equals 7.

\* All Accounting transfer students must fill out in Column A for transfer credits completed and accepted at ECSU. Column B - for all credits completed at ECSU only.

\*\* A minimum of 24 credit hours of the Advanced Accounting Requirements must be completed at ECSU for the Accounting Major Degree. No more than 2 Advanced Accounting courses can be transferred to Eastern. ACC 303 & 311 function as Writing Level II - Writing Enhanced courses for Accounting major students. If ACC 303 & 311 are transferred in, other Writing Level III courses must be taken for requirement.

\*\*\* Students majoring in Accounting are required to take ECO 200 to satisfy LAC - T1SS and ECO 201 to satisfy LAC - T2IS, which will count both towards the LAC Tier 1 and Tier 2 categories and the Accounting major (in other words "Double Count"). Only those two courses may double count between LAC Tiers 1 and 2 and the Accounting major.

## ACC 411 has been granted temporary approval to serve the LAC Tier 3 & Writing III Course for Accounting major students.

\*1 Students transferring with 30+ credits to ECSU, not having taken an LAC-T1SS course may take ECO 201 concurrently with a LAC-T1SS course with special permission from the Economics Department.  
\*2 Students transferring 30+ credits to ECSU, having not taken an LAC-T1M course may take ECO 215 concurrently with an LAC-T1M course with special permission from the Economics Department.

### Eastern Writing Requirements for Dept of Business Administration Majors:

All Eastern Students are required to complete university W1, W2, and W3 writing requirements: The W1 requirement is taking either English 100, 100P, 200 or HON 200. The W2 requirement is taking two Writing Enhanced courses approved for your major (BUS 201 and BUS 225) OR a total of taking two W3 approved courses within the Dept of Business Admin to satisfy both the W2 and W3 Writing Requirements. Example: A student transfers in ACC 301 and ACC 311 which were not Writing Enhanced courses at the other school, therefore the student takes his/her major's W3 course (ACC 411) and a second dept W3 course (BUS 301, BIS 377 or BUS 365) to satisfy both W2 and W3

**Additional Note:** Within the 120 credits required for the baccalaureate degree, 60 credits must be numbered 200 or higher, and at least 30 of these credits must be at the 300-400 level.

**Note:** Transfer students from one or more accredited institutions who enter with 60 or more transfer credits shall be considered to have met the rest of Eastern's Liberal Arts Program Tier I, including Natural Science with a lab providing that they transfer a minimum of 27 credits in liberal arts disciplines: humanities, social sciences and natural sciences.

==Transfer students that bring in 27 or more Liberal Arts credits may be waived of all LAC Tier 1 Requirements including the LAC 1 credit Natural Science Lab Requirement with the exception that ALL students must satisfy the T1W and T1M requirement. (this applies to students starting Fall 2011 or later)
