- Activate your Eastern email account.**
*Your Eastern email account will be used to convey important information regarding incoming student programs, placement testing, financial aid, and registration. Your **username** and **email address** are located in the lower right hand corner of your acceptance letter. Follow the directions in the letter to activate your account. Please monitor your Eastern email account on a regular basis.*
- Submit official transcript(s) from all previously-attended institutions as soon as possible.**
Transfer credit evaluations cannot be completed until official transcript(s) are submitted for review.
- Log onto eWeb Online Services at <http://eweb.easternct.edu> to view your transfer credit evaluation.** You will also be able to check grades, see your transcripts, add and drop classes, display your class schedule and review financial aid status through your *eWeb* account.
- Submit completed CSU health form prior to start of the fall semester.**
