The Global Citizenship Council is accepting applications to fund Eastern students planning to enroll for Global Field Courses for Summer 2012 and Study Abroad for Fall 2012. Scholarships may be used to support travel costs, tuition, and other fees. Scholarship awards will range from 20% of the cost of enrollment to a maximum of \$750. Awards will be based on financial need, and thus, a FAFSA application must be on file in the Financial Aid office by the due date of the application.

To apply for these scholarships, please send a one-page letter indicating your intended travel goals and how this opportunity for global education will further your education and career goals. Your letter must provide your Student ID number and up-to-date contact information including your phone number and email address. Students should also indicate whether they have a FAFSA application on file, and any extenuating financial circumstances that might inhibit your travel plans. Please send your letter to Carmen Diaz, Office of Academic Affairs, Gelsi-Young 2nd Floor by **March 15, 2012**.
