The Global Citizenship Council is accepting applications to fund Eastern students planning to enroll for Global Field Courses for Spring Break & Wintersession (2012) and Study Abroad for Spring 2012. Scholarships may be used to support travel costs and will range from 20% of these costs to a maximum of \$750. Awards will be based on financial need, and thus a FAFSA application must be on file in the Financial Aid office by the application date.

To apply for these scholarships, please send a one-page letter indicating your intended travel goals and how this opportunity will further your education and career goals. Provide your Student ID number and up-to-date contact information, including phone number and email address. Students should also indicate whether they have a FAFSA application on file, and any extenuating financial circumstances that might inhibit your travel plans. Please send your letter to **Carmen Diaz, Academic Affairs, Gelsi-Young 2nd Floor by Friday October 14, 2011**. Another round of scholarships will be announced for students planning to enroll for Global Field Courses offered in Summer 2012 in late Fall.
