**Alyx Kellington To
Come To Eastern**

Willimantic, Conn.- As part of Eastern Connecticut State University's (ECSU) Women's History Month celebration, photojournalist and world traveler, Alyx Kellington, will present "Love and Pain" on Thursday, March, 18 at 7 p.m. The presentation will be held in the Betty Tipton Room of the Student Center, located on Eastern's north campus.

In her presentation, Kellington will explore gender roles, the role of media and issues of indigenous peoples and human rights, while sharing her photographs and personal experiences with the audience.

As a photojournalist Kellington covered the first six months of the Zapatista uprising in Chiapas, Mexico. From 1992 to 1994 Kellington covered the political and economic changes that occurred in Haiti. These experiences in Mexico and Haiti, as well as others, will be shared with the audience during the Kellington speech.

Kellington has lectured in many high schools and universities about her travels and experiences.
