ECSU to Host Energy Conference

Willimantic—As part of its continued endeavor to increase public awareness of energy conservation, the Institute for Sustainable Energy of Eastern Connecticut State University (ECSU) will host a conference designed to address sustainability planning. The conference aims to create consistent terminology, messages and vision for promoting a sustainable energy future for our region. The three-day conference runs from **Monday, October 27 through Wednesday 29** at the Mohegan Sun in Uncasville.

Keynote speakers will include political officials and experts in the field of energy and environment. Workshops will feature presentations by “best of class-” leaders in sustainability at the state and community levels- as well as “green campus” advocates. Nonprofit organizations and agencies that provide support and resources for sustainability planning and implementation will add their expertise to the workshops. Attendees will be those responsible for energy and environmental policy on the federal, state, and local levels, university leadership, and energy and environmental professionals.
