Eastern's Harry Hope Theatre to Present *The Brother's M*

Willimantic, Conn.—Eastern Connecticut State University's (ECSU) Department of Performing Arts will host *The Brothers M—A Millennium Milestone in Theatre: Roman Comedy for All Ages* at 8 p.m. from Tuesday, Nov. 16 – Saturday, Nov. 20, with a matinee on Sunday, Nov. 21 at 4 p.m. All performances will be held in the Harry Hope Theatre, on the ground floor of Shafer Hall, located on the corner of Windham and Valley streets. Tickets are \$5 for students, \$10 for senior citizens, and \$12 for the general public.

The production will be directed by Larry Hunt, a guest artist of the Department of Performing Arts. Hunt is known for his expertise as an international mask and movement performer. He is also known for his directorship, as well as his work as a designer.

The *Brothers M* is based on one of Plautus' most famous plays, *The Brothers Menaechmus*. Shakespeare used this play as his inspiration for *The Comedy of Errors*.
