Summer Academy Workshop for Teachers at Eastern

Willimantic, CT – More than 27 teachers from 14 districts across eastern Connecticut will participate in the Summer Academy Workshop to be held at Eastern Connecticut State University. The two-week workshop began on June 27 and concludes on July 8.

The workshop is the result of a Teacher Quality Enhancement grant from the Connecticut Department of Higher Education. The grant entitled, “Summer Academy for Integrated Science and Mathematics,” is designed for teachers in grades 7 and 8. Teachers participate in several small workshops focusing on different areas, such as algebra, plate tectonics, landforms produced by glaciers and people, data analysis tools, and genetics. Workshops are conducted on the fourth floor of the J. Eugene Smith Library during the morning sessions beginning at 8 a.m., and in Room 221 of the Sports Center in the afternoon, beginning at 12:45 p.m.
