## **Fall Open House at Eastern**

Willimantic, Conn.— Eastern Connecticut State University will hold its Fall Open House on **Sunday, Oct. 23 from 1 to 4 p.m. in the Sports Center.**

Eastern will open its doors to more than 2,000 prospective students and their families on Sunday afternoon. University administration, faculty, staff and students have planned a program that will enable prospective students to get a firsthand look at Eastern's academic majors, minors and student services, as well as the chance to meet with faculty members, current students and Eastern's President David G. Carter.
