University Hour Gets Heart Smart with Lisa Salberg

Willimantic, CT-- Cardiac specialist Lisa Salberg will speak at Eastern Connecticut State University on Nov. 2. Salberg's lecture, which is part of Eastern's University Hour series, will take place at 3 p.m. in Shafer Auditorium. The public is invited. Admission is free.

Salberg, a representative from the Hypertrophic Cardiomyopathy Association, will deliver a presentation on sudden cardiac death. Hypertrophic Cardiomyopathy (HCM) is a condition of excessive thickening of the heart muscle. The association is currently hosting, "Let the Beat Go On," a campaign to galvanize awareness of the condition. The goal is to raise awareness and to encourage people at risk to be tested.
