Eastern Students to Present in Excellence Expo

Willimantic- More than 200 Eastern Connecticut State University students from the business administration, communications, economics, education, and health and physical education departments will participate at the 6th Annual Excellence Expo on April 26. The expo, which is sponsored by the School of Education/Professional Studies and Graduate Division, takes place from 1:30-4:30 p.m.

“The Excellence Expo provides Eastern’s undergraduate and graduate students with an opportunity to present scholarly research and creative expressions to the larger university community,” said Tuesday Cooper, associate dean of the School of Education/Professional Studies and Graduate Division. “Students will make presentations on a variety of topics such as law and ethics, economics (both domestic and international), marketing and public relations.”

The expo will begin with an opening ceremony at 1:30 p.m. in the Paul E. Johnson, Sr. Community Conference Room, located in the J. Eugene Smith Library.

Presentations will begin at 2 p.m. and end at 4 p.m. The popular poster contest takes place in the Francis E. Geissler Gymnasium, located in the Sports Center. Students in the poster contest will be judged on originality, clarity, insight and overall presentation. PowerPoint presentations will be held in Webb Hall. Students will be judged on their content,
