Professional Master Class Workshops

Willimantic, CT – Two professors from Eastern Connecticut State University will lead a series of art workshops at the Windham Arts Center in Willimantic this fall.

The Saturday Master Classes presented by the Windham Area Arts Collaborative feature five different workshops focusing on areas, such as Chinese painting and wash, portrait painting, bookmaking, and creating a visual journal.

Imna Arroyo, professor of art and former chair of the Visual Arts Department, will instruct two of the workshops. Arroyo has received numerous awards and grants. She has participated in diverse national and international exhibitions and her work is represented in several permanent collections, including the Museum of Modern Art/Franklin Furnace Art Book Collection, and the Schomberg Collection of American Art in the Schomberg Center for Research and Black Culture.

Qimin Liu, also an art professor at Eastern, will be in charge of two three-day workshops. Liu, was born in China and holds a master's degree from Iowa State University, as well as a master's degree in Fine Arts from the Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts.
