Willimantic, CT - More than 200 Eastern Connecticut State University (ECSU) students from business administration, communications, economics, education, and health and physical education departments will present at the 7th Annual Excellence Expo on April 25. The expo, which is sponsored by the School of Education and Professional Studies, takes place from 2 to 4:30 p.m.

“The Excellence Expo provides Eastern’s undergraduate and graduate students with an opportunity to present scholarly research and creative expression to the larger university community,” said Tuesday Cooper, associate dean of the School of Education and Professional Studies. “Students will present on a variety of topics such as early childhood education, advertising campaigns, economics, fitness, business marketing plans and health. Students in the poster exhibition will be judged on originality, clarity, insight and overall presentation. PowerPoint presentations will be held in Webb Hall. Students will be judged on their content, presentation

and overall presentation. In addition, WECS-FM Radio (90.1) will broadcast “All Ears Radio Theatre” LIVE!

At 4:30 p.m., participants reconvene in the Paul E. Johnson Community Conference Room for the closing ceremony and awarding of the prizes.
