

LAC, LACE, Major Explanations

Please Note: Column F on the Cluster Schedule designates clusters as LAC, LACE, or Major.

- An LAC cluster can be a two or three-course cluster having one or two Tier 1 LAC courses linked to an FYR 174 Resource, Research, and Responsibilities course. These clusters, which can generally be taken by almost any student, could contain a course that would be appropriate for a particular major.
- An LACE cluster is a three-course cluster (i.e., two courses linked to an FYR 174 course). Typically, one course satisfies a Tier I LAC course requirement and the other course satisfies a major or elective requirement. These clusters will always be recommended for one or more majors, but could be taken by almost any first-time student.
- A Major cluster can be a two or three-course cluster that is restricted to students majoring in a specific discipline. No other students are permitted to enroll in a major cluster.
