

Current Residential Eastern Students: (requesting housing for the fall 2010 semester)

1. All current residential students requesting fall housing must complete the on-line housing intent survey and pay the non-refundable \$250 housing deposit by the March 17th deadline. There is no guarantee of housing.
2. Students must submit both by the deadline in order to be eligible for the room draw process. Students who do not complete the deposit and/or intent survey by the deadline are automatically wait-listed, no exceptions. There is no guarantee of housing.
3. The housing intent survey gives students the following options and students must attend all room draw activities related to the option they select:
 - a. Not returning to housing (select appropriate reason on intent survey)
 - b. First-year students participating in the Room Draw process
 - i. First-year students opting to participate in room draw will be randomly assigned a ticket number and will be required to return a room draw registration form by the given deadline. Students have the option of creating a registration form with up to 4 current resident students. There is no guarantee of placement with students on the form.
 - ii. Students must then attend Room Draw on April 21st in the Gym from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. to select a spot. Room draw is not an appropriate reason to miss class. You can send a proxy to select housing for you (person with signed letter from you giving them permission to select for you).
 - iii. Historically, we run out of spaces for first-year room draw prior to all students being able to select housing. Students who will not be able to select housing (due to their number and the number of available spots) will be notified via email one week prior to room draw and those students do not need to attend. Students are placed on the wait list in ticket order and will be assigned as spaces become available. Historically, we have always been able to accommodate students from this wait list into housing, although housing is not guaranteed.
 - c. Return to the same spot (current upperclassmen halls only)
 - i. This is the last year that any student has the ability to “squat” (remain in current assignment). Students selecting this option have no further steps.
 - ii. Nutmeg Hall 1st, 2nd and 3rd floors will be used for intersession housing. Students living on these floors must move completely out of their apartments on December 17, 2010 when going home for break.
 - d. Internal room draw within current hall (current upperclassmen only)
 - i. Students are eligible to participate only if they are interested in moving to another spot within their current hall. Students will be notified by their Hall Director with date/time if they select this option.
 - ii. Nutmeg Hall 1st, 2nd and 3rd floors will be used for intersession housing. Students living on these floors must move completely out of their apartments on December 17, 2010 when going home for break.
 - e. Upperclassmen room draw to move to a different hall (current upperclassmen only)
 - i. Current upperclassmen and transfer students are eligible for this process, regardless of their current hall. Students opting to participate in room draw will be randomly assigned a ticket number and will be required to return a room draw registration form by the given deadline. Students have the option of creating a registration form with up to 4 current resident students. There is no guarantee of placement with students on the form.
 - ii. Students must then attend Room Draw on April 13th in the Betty Tipton Room from 8 p.m. – 10 p.m. to select a spot. Room draw is not an appropriate reason to miss class. You can send a proxy to select housing for you (person with signed letter from you giving them permission to select for you).
 - iii. Nutmeg Hall 1st, 2nd and 3rd floors will be used for intersession housing. Students living on these floors must move completely out of their apartments on December 17, 2010 when going home for break.
