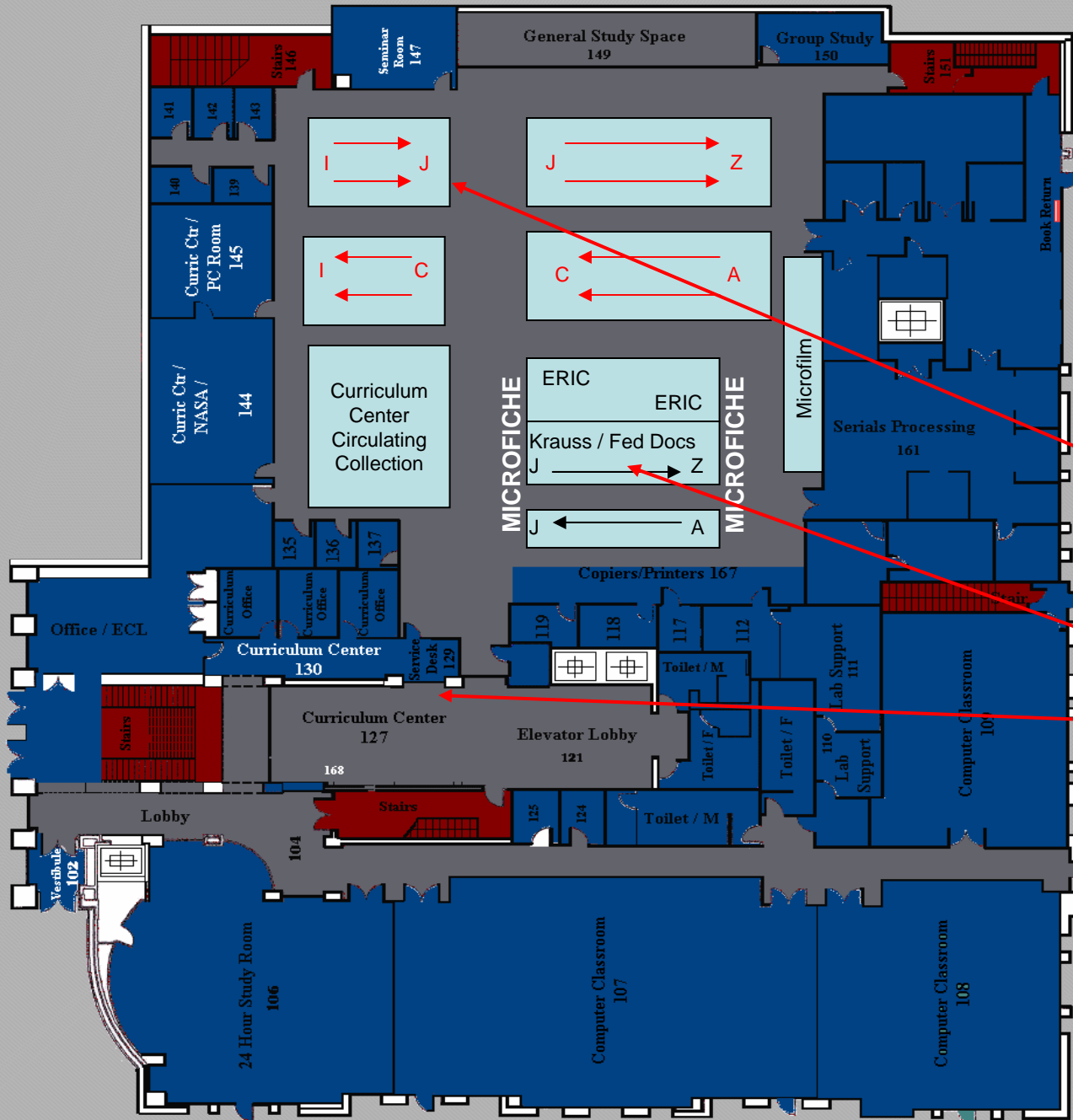


First Floor



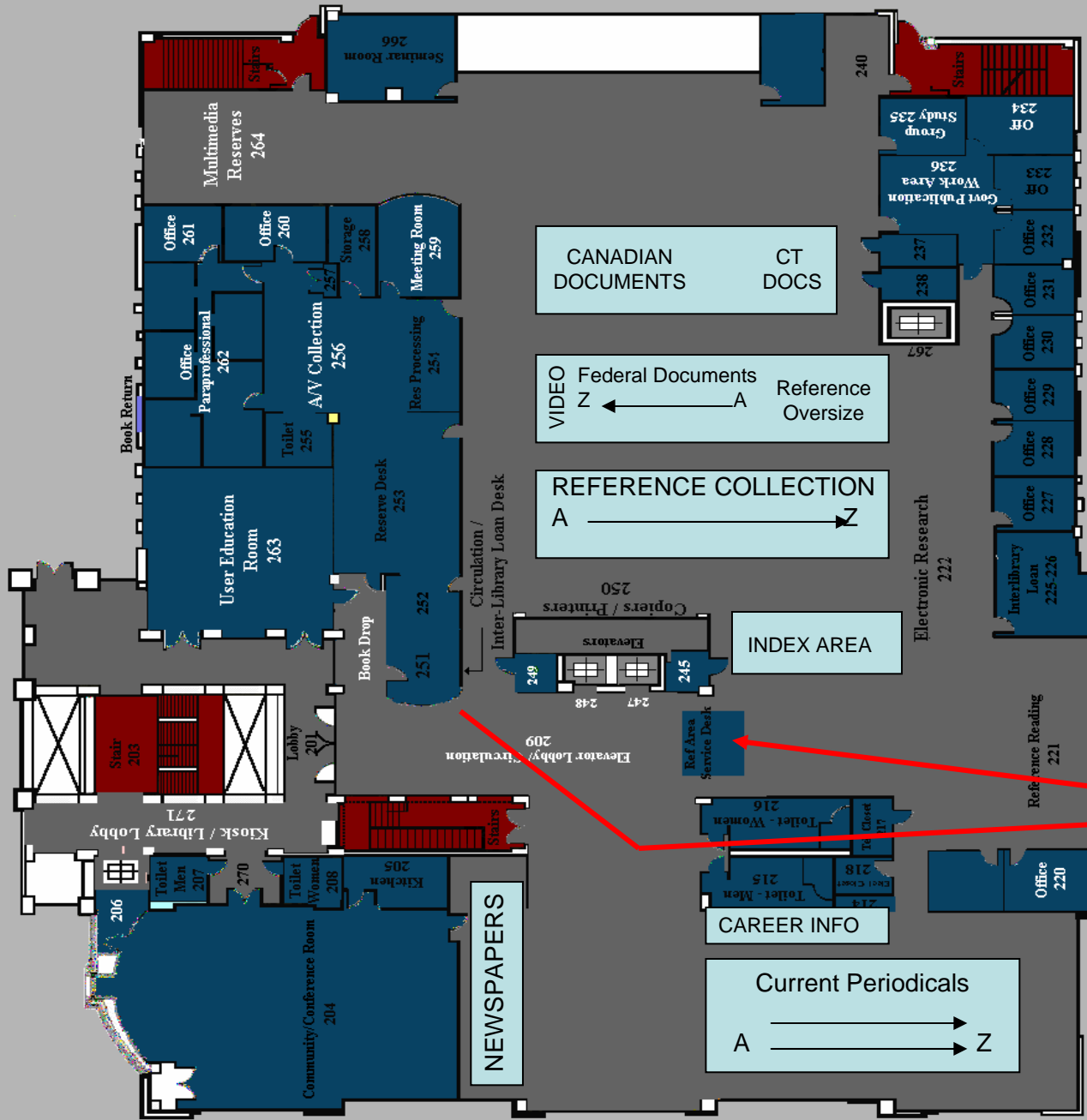
Library First Floor Stacks:

This map shows where the Books & Journals are located. The **Journals are shelved in Alphabetical Order using the Journal Title. All journals are in order from A-Z.** The starting and ending letters for each row of shelves are indicated along with the direction the order travels. For example the Journal **Journal of Children's Literature**, shows a location of BOUND. This journal would be found in the I through J section (see arrow on diagram). The **New York Times Magazine** shows a location of **MICROFICHE**. This journal would be found in the J through Z section of the **microfiche cabinets**.

Library Second Floor Stacks:

This map shows where the stacks (books) are located. The reference books are shelved using the Library of Congress Classification. All books are in order from A-Z. The starting and ending call numbers or letters for each row of shelves are indicated along with the direction the order travels.

This floor contains the following collections:

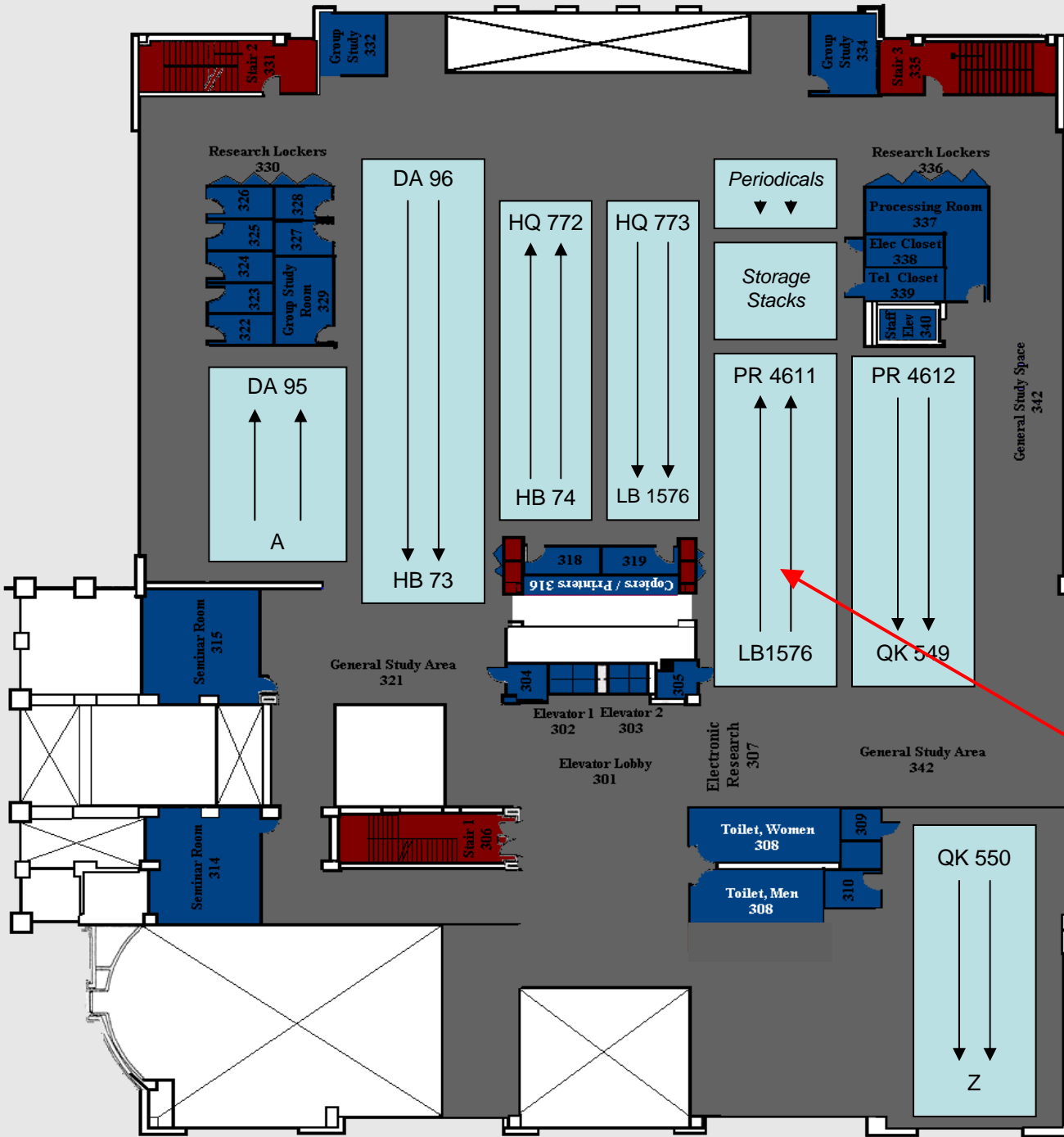
- Reference

Third Floor

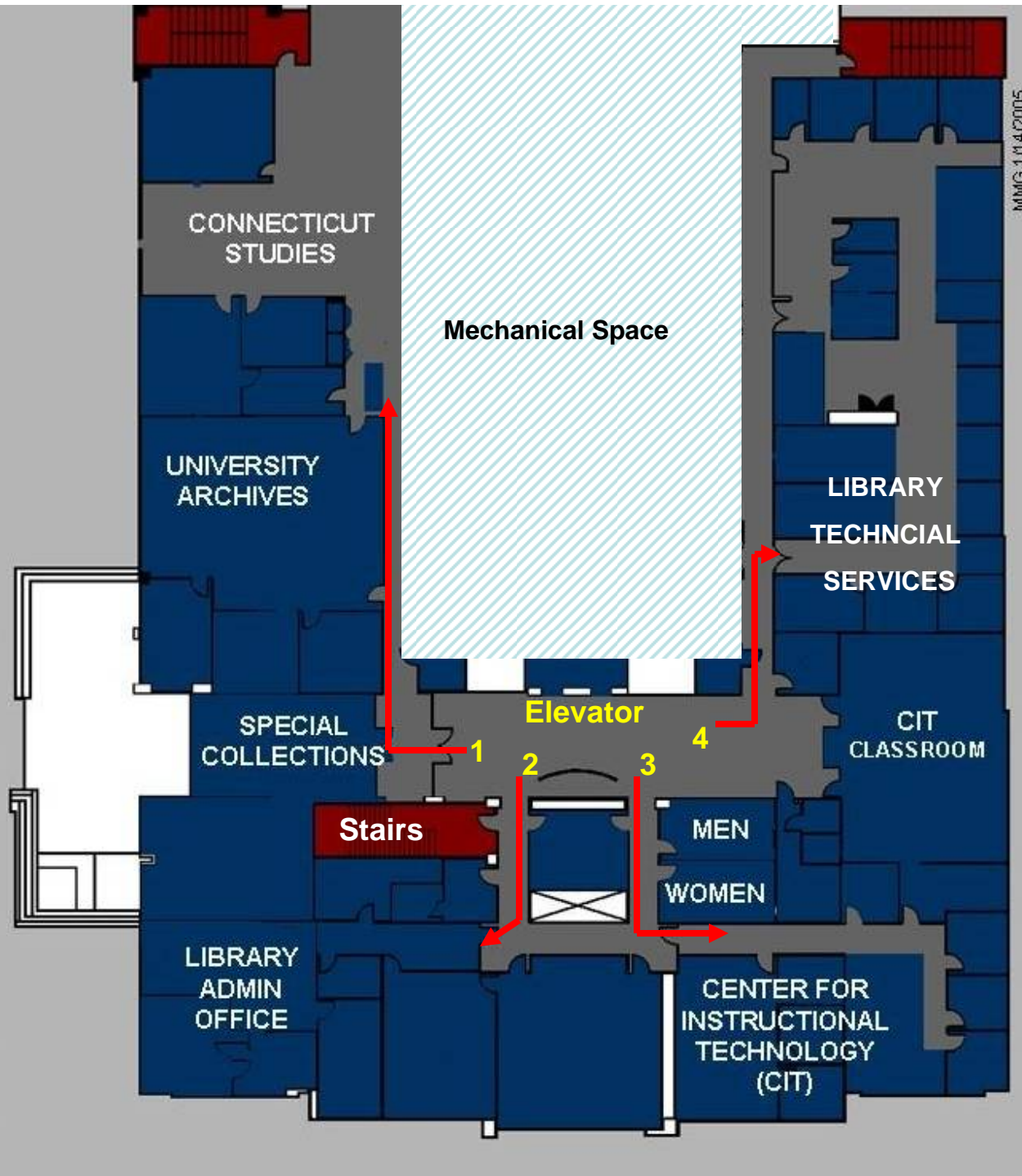


Library Third Floor Stacks:

This map shows the stacks where most books are located. Books are shelved using the Library of Congress Classification. All books are in order from A-Z. The starting and ending call numbers for each row of shelves are indicated along with the direction the order travels. For example the title **Pockets of Hope: How Students and Teachers Change the World**, shows a location of ECSU Stacks, and a call number of **LC 196.5.U6 D42 2002**. This book would be found in the LB1576 through PR 4611 stacks.
