Federal Reserve Official Comes To Eastern

Willimantic, Conn. – Jeffrey C. Fuhrer, executive vice-president and director of research for the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston, will speak at Eastern Connecticut State University on Feb. 26. Fuhrer's presentation which is sponsored by the David T. Chase Free Enterprise Institute, begins at 11 a.m. in the Paul E. Johnson Sr. Community Conference Room of the J. Eugene Smith Library. Fuhrer will discuss current regional, national and international economic trends with particular emphasis on the regional New England economy. The public is invited. Admission is free.

Fuhrer has done research on econometric inflation, interest rate and employment models, and on monetary policy initiatives by the Federal Reserve System.

Fuhrer received his undergraduate degree in economics from Princeton University, and his M.A. and Ph.D. degrees in economics from Harvard University.
