To recent high school graduates with AP course credit:

Congratulations! Your successful performance on AP[®] Exams can earn you valuable college credit. If you achieved a score of 3 or higher on at least one AP Exam, the following Connecticut public colleges and universities grant college credit for AP Exam scores of 3 or higher:

- All Connecticut Community Colleges
- Central Connecticut State University
- Eastern Connecticut State University
- Southern Connecticut State University
- Western Connecticut State University
- Charter Oak State College

You can use AP credit at these schools to place out of introductory college courses and move directly into the courses you're academically prepared for. This can save you money on tuition costs and help you graduate on time.

If you're planning to attend one of Connecticut's community colleges, state universities, or Charter Oak State College this fall or later, remember to send your official AP Exam scores to ensure you receive this tuition-free college credit.
