Montgomery GI Bill Active Duty (MGIB-AD) -For reservists with a six year obligation.

STEP 1. Bring the following forms to the Financial Aid Office:

- a. \*Certificate of Eligibility (COE)
- b. \* Data Form
- c. \* tuition form If applicable
- d. Copy of your DD 214 member 4 (not appl. For dependents)
- e. Course Plan (for Bachelors of General Studies major only)

STEP 2. Paperwork Processing

<u>The staff</u> in the VA Financial Aid office will process this request for you. They will send the request to the VA-Educational Office in Buffalo, NY. (3-4-week process time).

Once the information is verified, you will receive a letter from the VA with approval.
