What is STEP/CAP?

STEP/CAP is an invitation-only summer program designed to ensure students are prepared for the rigors of college coursework at Eastern. Students invited to this program have been selected based on demonstrated perseverance and commitment to academic achievement. This six-week summer residential experience offers the opportunity to take three college-level courses while building critical academic skills within a supportive community. Students sign a contract pledging to complete the program with at least a 2.5 GPA. Successful completion of STEP/CAP ensures a seat in the incoming Fall 2024 class.

The STEP/CAP Scholarship



Eastern recognizes the dedication needed to earn a college degree. To help reduce the cost of attendance and ensure future success at Eastern, eligible students who successfully complete the summer program are granted a STEP/CAP scholarship that will be applied starting in the fall semester. The scholarship is renewable for four years (eight semesters)* and is in addition to need-based aid.

Students build a network of STEP/CAP staff, faculty and student leaders to assist with the transition to Eastern. This network supports the overall well-being for all students in the program.
