MUSEUM STUDIES INDIVIDUALIZED MAJOR

This individualized major is designed by combining two major disciplines, i.e. Art History and History/Anthropology, and adding other courses that will prepare the student for graduate studies in Museum and Digital Collection Studies.

Besides coursework, the student will acquire hands-on experience by working closely with the Art gallery director and by conducting an internship. As a capstone course, the student will design and put together an exhibit whether on site or online. The student will focus on at least one area (American, Latin American, Islam, Middle East, Asia, Gender, etc.) and one time period.
