Vocational Rehabilitation (VOC REHAB)

Vocational Rehabilitation is a GI Benefit for former military members who have a memorandum rating of 10% or more from the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), and Apply for VR&E services.

Follow these Steps to complete Voc Rehab activation and school coverage.

- Step 1: Apply for COE (Certificate of Eligibility) for VOC Rehab
- Step 2: Apply to Eastern Connecticut State University & Register for classes
- Step 3: Receive VOC Rehab information
 - Once the request has been submitted you will receive a packet from VOC Rehab in the mail. This
 packet will provide information and instructions. You will also find your VOC Rehab counselor
 information there.
 - 2. Contact your Voc Rehab counselor and set up your initial appointment.

Step 4: Report to the Eastern's VA Financial Aid Office

- Once you are approved with the VOC Rehab program, make an appointment with the Eastern's VA Financial Aid department.
- > Bring the following documents to your appointment
 - 1. Data Form *
 - 2. Class Schedule
 - 3. VA Form 28-1905 (issued by Voc Rehab Counselor)
 - 4. Certificate of Eligibility (COE)*

Step 5: You will receive an automatic email from the VA once your 1905 has been processed by Eastern Connecticut State University.

Step 6: You will receive another e-mail from the Financial Aid Office that your 1905 book stipend benefit has been processed. Allow 24 hours, before going to the book store.

All Voc Rehab recipients, Remember:

- Yearly appointment with your counselor are mandatory.
- Grades submitted to counselor every semester by student.
