<p>Students Accessing MS Azure Dev Tools for Teaching – Education Hub for the first time, please follow the steps below for your student’s account to be associated with the Microsoft Azure Dev Tools for Teaching.</p> <p>Step 1: Go to https://my.visualstudio.com</p> <p>Step 2: Click on the ‘Create one!’ hyperlink</p> <p>Step 3: On the “Create account” page, enter your school provided or Personal email address and hit ‘Next’</p> <p>Step 4: Create your password then hit ‘Next’ – This will trigger an email that contains a verification code</p> <p>Step 5: Enter the code that you received and hit ‘Next’</p> <p>Step 6: Just follow the prompt and fill out all the required details.</p> <p>Once the student email address has been associated into a Microsoft account, please try to log in to the Education Hub.</p>	<p>Here are the steps that students/users can follow to access the software catalog through the new Education Hub</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
