Pursue and secure an internship experience and keep track of your accomplishments

Choose elective classes or a minor to enhance your skills and support your professional goals

Update your resume and have it reviewed by the OCS staff

Thinking about graduate or professional school? Start researching programs and requirements

If you haven't already, seek out leadership roles in clubs and organizations

Pursue academic research and projects with professors to expand your practical experience

Continue to grow your network by engaging in campus events and programs

Start asking faculty and professional contacts to serve as professional references



Finalize your resume and have it reviewed by the OCS staff and your faculty advisor

Start your job search process; utilize ECN and other job search engines to identify opportunities

Grow your network through career fairs and LinkedIn

Use your network to identify professional opportunities beyond job postings

Join professional organizations to meet other professionals in your field of interest

Participate in mock/practice interviews often

Complete your degree evaluation and meet with your advisor to make sure you are meeting all your graduation requirements
