  - **For Mac:** Safari

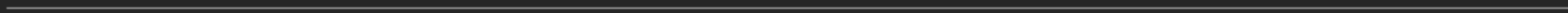

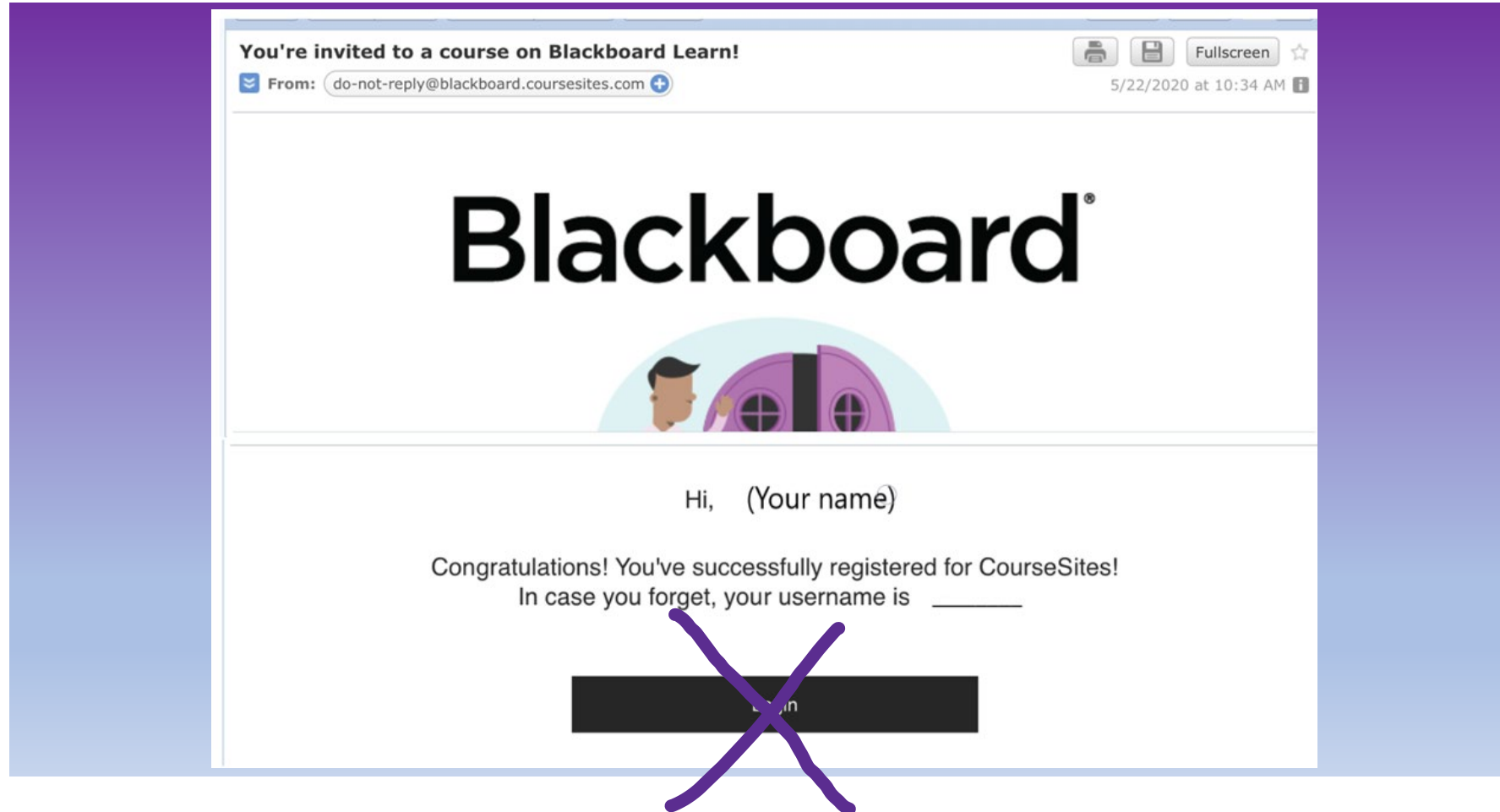
