



## INSTRUCTOR CREDENTIAL REQUIREMENTS

### ART

- ART 110, ART 202, ART 215, ART 217
  - *Degree required:* MFA in Studio Art OR Bachelor's degree in Studio Art and Master's degree in a related field

### BIOLOGY

- BIO 200:
  - *Degree preferred:* Master's in Biology or related field
  - *Also considered:* Master's in Education with Ecology coursework
  - No lab experience required
- BIO 204:
  - *Degree preferred:* Master's in Biology or related field
  - *Also considered:* Master's in Education with appropriate background in Physiology
  - *Additional expertise or experience required:* The instructor must have knowledge of human physiology and experience working in a classroom laboratory setting.

### BUSINESS

- BUS 201 & 225:
  - *Degree required:* Master's of Business Administration (MBA); Master's of Science in Management, Marketing, or Business Education; or a related MSc in Business

### COMMUNICATION

- COM 230:
  - *Degree required:* Master's degree in Communication or any related field (including Education) or any related field (including Education)

- An instructor may be appointed provided the candidate has credentials and/or experience substantially comparable to the listed standards for the department.

## **COMPUTER SCIENCE**

- CSC 101:
  - *Degree required:* Master's or Ph.D. in Computer Science or a related field

## **CRIMINOLOGY**

- CRM 102:
  - *Degree required:* Master's degree in Sociology, Criminology, or a related field in ESPS careers with relevant coursework and/or teaching experience

## **ENGLISH**

- ENG 125:
  - *Degree preferred:* Master's in English
  - *Also considered:* Master's in Education and experience teaching and studying literature
- ENG 201:
  - *Degree preferred:* MFA in Creative Writing OR a Ph. D. in Comp/Rhet, Writing Studies, or a related field
  - *Also considered:* Master's in a relevant subject and a record of peer-reviewed literary journal and/or book publication

## **ENVIRONMENTAL EARTH SCIENCE**

- EES 205:
  - *Degree required:* Master's in a relevant scientific discipline OR Master's in Education with relevant coursework

## **FRENCH**

- *FRE 210 & 211:*
  - Degree required: Master's degree in French or an allied field, such as linguistics or education
  - College teaching experience preferred

## HEALTH SCIENCES

- HSC 225:
  - *Degree required:* Master's degree in a related discipline (including Education) or a similar relevant degree (e.g., a different degree in a medical field)

## HISTORY

- HIS 120 & 121:
  - *Degree preferred:* Master's in History
  - *Also considered:* Bachelor's degree in History with a Master's degree in another field that includes graduate coursework in History

## MATHEMATICS

- MAT 135P, MAT 155, MAT 216, MAT 243, & MAT 244:
  - *Degree preferred:* Master's degree in mathematics or a related field (e.g., Mathematics Education)
  - *Also considered:* Master's in a scientific field plus experience teaching math

## MUSIC

- MUS 100:
  - *Degree required:* Bachelor's degree in Music and a Master's degree in either Music or Education

## POLITICAL SCIENCE

- PSC 100:
  - *Degree preferred:* M.A. or Ph.D. in Political Science or advanced degree in a related field
  - *Also considered:* Master's in Education plus experience teaching political science or related courses

## PSYCHOLOGY

- PSY 100:
  - *Degree preferred:* Master's degree in Psychology or a related field
  - *Also considered:* Master's degree in Education with relevant coursework and/or teaching experience (especially teaching AP Psychology)

## SPANISH

- SPA 110, 111, 210, & 211:
  - *Degree required:* Master's degree in Spanish or an allied field such as Linguistics or Education
  - College teaching experience preferred
