

Tk20 edTPA for Students

- **You need an active paid tk20 account in order to access the listed functionalities.**
- Log into Tk20 via: easternct.tk20.com
 - a. Your username is your Eastern userid (email address before the @).
 - b. Your password is your Eastern email password.
- You will be presented with a list of menu items on the left hand side of the window. Select Portfolios from the menu then click on the edTPA Portfolio.
- Check to that you have received the correct type of edTPA portfolio template. The portfolio needs to match your subject area major. If you have received the wrong type of edTPA portfolio, contact tk20@easternct.edu
- Review the instructions and download all documents on the first Tab of the portfolio. You will need to access the subject area handbook before you can complete the edTPA. Use the username: edtpa and password: tk20! to access the handbook.

Clicking "Transfer to Pearson" transfers your portfolio to Pearson, and automatically submits your portfolio to assigned on-campus assessors.

- Video files must be compressed to less than 500MB and should not be in HD. For more information and how to compress videos view [Tk20- Guidelines and Best Practices for File Uploads](#).
- Once the portfolio is completed, it needs to be transferred to Pearson for scoring. To complete this step, register with Pearson and purchase an authorization key. Enter the key on the Tk20 portfolio and select "Transfer to Pearson" to send the edTPA to Pearson.
