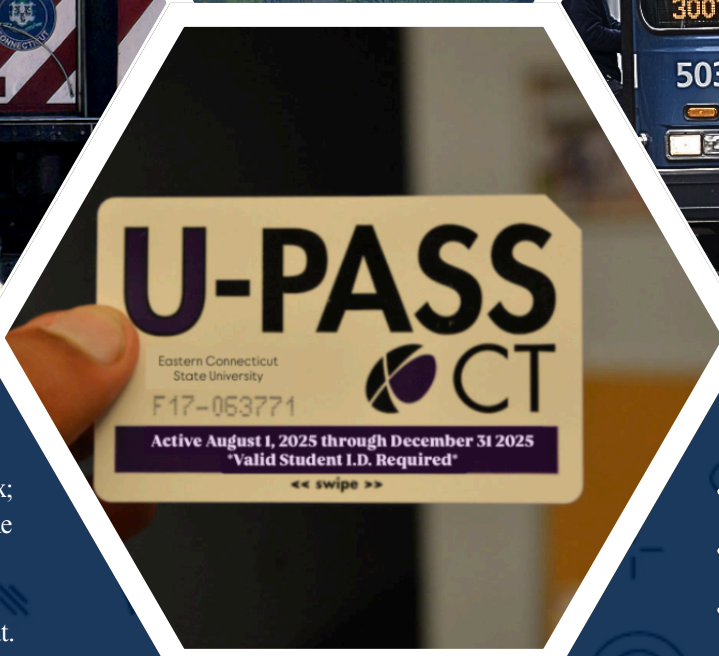


U-PASS CT EASTERN CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY

Explore Connecticut – for free!

Fall pass valid Aug. 1 – Dec. 31
Spring pass valid Jan. 1 – July 31

Eastern students can pick up their U-Pass at the Bursar's Office window (Wood Support Services Center, 2nd floor) by presenting a valid student ID. Lost or stolen passes should also be reported there.



How It Works?

Buses: Show the driver your U-Pass and student ID. Insert the pass into the farebox; wait for the “beep.” Pull the signal cord one block before your stop.

Trains: Board at any station in Connecticut. When the conductor asks for tickets, show your U-Pass and student ID. Travel must remain within Connecticut.

Metro-North to NYC: U-Pass covers travel within Connecticut. From New Haven to New York City, students only pay the out-of-state portion (around \$13 instead of \$26+).

Benefits

- Unlimited rides on most CT bus and train systems
- Significant discount on trips to NYC via Metro-North
- Supports sustainability by reducing emissions and improving mobility
- Accessible to all undergraduates, both residential and commuter

Valid Transit Systems

Valid for Eastern Students:

- WRTD (Windham Region Transit District) – local Willimantic service *
- CTtransit statewide (includes Express & CTfastrak)
- CTrail Hartford Line (New Haven ↔ Springfield; select Amtrak trains)
- CTrail Shore Line East
- SEAT (South-East Area Transit) – New London/Norwich region
- Magic Carpet (Enfield) – connections north of Hartford

Not Accepted:

- I-Bus Express (Stamford ↔ White Plains)
- Private inter-city buses
- Out-of-state Amtrak routes
