ABOUT THE COURSE

Students explore the relationship between culture and education through a spring break global field experience in Dublin, Ireland. Through twice-monthly evening meetings, students will gain essential background on Irish education and culture in preparation for the global field experience. During Spring Break 2026, students will travel to Dublin to explore schools and society firsthand, celebrate St. Patrick's Day, tour cultural and literary sites, experience local arts and heritage, and engage with themes like sustainability, diversity, and university life in Ireland. This course may serve as a pre-requisite course option for the undergraduate elementary, secondary, and health/physical education teaching certification programs, as well as a Liberal Arts Core Curriculum disciplinary perspective course in the social sciences focusing on critical thinking.
