This course will introduce topics related to New England environmental earth science in preparation for the 8-day May field course across New Hampshire, Maine, and Massachusetts. They will explore key field sites in the White Mountains, Coastal Maine, and Cape Cod, making original observations that reinforce and expand on classroom concepts. The experience includes hands-on field geology in mountainous and coastal terrains, enhancing students' practical skills and career readiness in environmental and earth sciences.
