ABOUT THE COURSE


This unforgettable course explores the flourishing of vocal music in Vienna from the First Viennese School through the early Romantic period (c. 1760–1850), focusing on works by Haydn, Mozart, Beethoven, and Schubert. Students will examine how these masterpieces were shaped by—and helped shape—the vibrant cultural, social, and aesthetic movements of their time.

The course culminates in a 11-day trip to Vienna. Wander the elegant streets of its historic center, attend world-class performances at the Vienna State Opera and Musikverein, and visit the opulent Hofburg and Schönbrunn Palaces. Explore top museums and galleries, then cap off the journey with a day trip to Salzburg, Mozart's picturesque birthplace nestled beneath the Austrian Alps.
