REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's degree with a minimum 2.75 GPA (on a 4.0 scale)
- Acceptance as a matriculated student into a graduate program at a Connecticut State University
- 2-year commitment to the internship is preferred
- Must be able to work 35 hours a week; some nights and weekends
- Demonstrate ability to serve students of diverse backgrounds
- Demonstrate commitment to equity, diversity, and inclusion that centers social and racial justice and intersectionality
- Be willing to collaborate with staff, campus partners and students of diverse backgrounds
- Demonstrate organizational and administrative skills
- Commitment to student development preferred
- Strong written and verbal communication skills required
- Able to take initiative on projects, multi-task and problem solve
- Ability to begin internship and coursework in May 2022

COMPENSATION

A \$20,000 stipend for 12 months.
Tuition fee waiver for part-time study.
Students are responsible for other fees as applicable.

May include: travel and delegate fees to a regional conference for the first year of study and a national conference for the second year of study.
