

HISTORY AND SOCIAL SCIENCE MAJOR (BA)

For students entering Fall 2022 onward

A grade of C or better is required in each course used in the major.
Majors must complete at least 15 History credits in residence at Eastern.

History Electives: (15 credits)

A minimum of five history electives at the 200-level or above (maximum of one 200-level course), excluding HIS 310. Two from U.S., two from Global; the fifth elective can come from either.

United States history: at least two courses

Global history (Europe, Asia, Africa, Latin America): at least two courses

Social Science Electives: Four electives from ANT, ECO, GEO, PSC, PSY or SOC; (12 credits) Students seeking certification should check on the EDU program's requirements

400-level seminar (HIS 400/406/407) (4 credits)

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Note: For most History and Social Science majors, HIS 115/116/120/121 will fulfill Tier I Historical Perspectives; HIS 230/231 will fulfill Tier II Cultural Perspectives. Social Science courses cannot be counted in both the LAC and the Major, but they *may* also count in the State Certification requirements (for Secondary Ed). HIS 200 fulfills the mid-level writing requirement; HIS 400/406/407 fulfills the university writing-intensive course requirement.

Total for graduation is 120 credits and it must include 60 credits at 200-level or higher and at least 30 credits at 300-level or higher.
