## SETTING UP YOUR HOME AWAY FROM HOME

We want our Warriors to make their housing assignment their home away from home. Self-Adhesive LED strip lights, posters, tapestries and decorations are very popular with our students, and we want to remind students that any damages left after a student moves out could result in damage billing being applied to the student's account.

Some suggestions we can offer include:

Instead of using self-adhesive LED strip lights, use painter's tape to hang them on the walls.

Instead of hanging/draping tapestries or flags over lights (strictly prohibited), use color changing light bulbs.

Instead of candles or wax warmers, use battery operated candles or plug-in air fresheners.

Painter's tape is the only University approved adhesive to use in residence halls.

## PROHIBITED ITEMS LIST BEST TO LEAVE THESE AT HOME

The following items are prohibited from all residence halls as they pose a health and safety risk or they are known to cause damages to University property. All rooms/suites/apartments are inspected regularly or as needed by Housing & Residential Life staff. Any item found that poses a health and safety risk or a damage risk will be confiscated by staff, stored (unless the item needs to be held by Campus Police), the student may be entered into the Student Conduct Process, and the student may receive billing for damages caused to University property. This list may be added to or updated at anytime by the University should a safety concern arise.

- ⊗ Air gun, paintball markers/guns, fireworks, incendiary devices
- ⊗ Amplifiers, electric guitars, drums etc.
- (x) Candles, incense, and wax warmers
- ⊗ Charcoal/propane grills, blow torches, lighter fluid, etc.
- ⊗ Cinder blocks
- Double sided tape, duct tape, nails, screws etc. on walls
   (painter's tape should be used on walls and students may use thumb tacks on sheet rock walls)
- ⊗ Drugs and alcohol (including cannabis in all forms)
- Drug and alcohol paraphernalia (including but not limited to shot glasses, bongs, vaporizers, hookahs, empty alcohol containers)
- ⊗ Electric blankets and electric heating pads
- Extension cords and power taps (only UL approved surge protectors are permitted)
- (X) Halogen lights/lamps, lava lamps, and "octopus lamps" with plastic shades

- ⊗ Pets (except fish in 10 gallon tank or less)
- Personal furniture
   (ie. couches, chairs, recliners, beds, mattresses etc)
- ⊗ Official/public signs and street signs (ie. stop signs, street signs, etc.)
- Self-adhesive LED strip lights
  (can be hung using painters tape or thumb tacks in sheet rock)

- (x) Weapons of any kind
- (x) Weight lifting equipment
- (x) Wicker furniture
- (x) Wireless routers
- (x) Wooden futons (metal-framed futons are acceptable)

## PROHIBITED ITEMS IN FIRST-YEAR RESIDENCE HALLS & NIEJADLIK HALL:

All cooking and heating appliances, included but not limited to:

- ⊗ Air fyer
- **Solution** Bread maker
- ⊗ Camping stove/propane or sterno cooking
- ⊗ Coffee pot (Keurig style coffee makers permitted)

- ⊗ Electric tea kettle
- ⊗ Hot plate/electric burner
- ⊗ Instant Pot/electric pressure cooker
- ⊗ Rice cooker

Cooking appliances are permitted on the 1st and 2nd floors of Occum Hall in kitchen area only. Microwaves permitted in all halls.
