## Study Descriptions

### Neurodivergent Surveillance

3 credits / 30 – 60 minutes / Location: Goddard 114 (Cognition Lab - enter through Goddard lobby). In this study, you will complete three tasks where you will search for target events on a computer screen (brightness change, motion change, and drowning). You will also complete a demographic survey, a survey about behaviors associated with autism, and a survey about behaviors associated with ADHD. Participation does NOT require diagnosis or suspected autism or ADHD.
